

JOB POSTING: Youth Connections Team Leader (Summer Student)

Community Living Kincardine and District is looking for a full-time summer student to fill the role of Team Leader in our Youth Connections program. The Youth Connections Team Leader will work collaboratively with the Family Support team to plan meaningful and engaging summer programming for youth with developmental disabilities. Accessing community-based activities and opportunities helps these youth to build positive relationships, enhance their level of integration and improve their sense of belonging.

Working one-on-one or with small groups, the Team Leader will directly support youth as they participate in a variety of recreation and skill-building opportunities, such as volunteering at a cat shelter, visiting the Bruce County Museum, walking the trails, learning to cook, mini-golfing with friends and taking part in summer festivals and events. The Team Leader will use a person-directed approach to understand the unique interests and goals of each participant and select activities that align with their personal skills, capabilities and support needs.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Work with the Family Support Team to research and identify local community-based recreational and volunteer opportunities
- Use a person-directed approach to plan, organize and schedule a diverse calendar of activities for individual participants and small groups
- Provide direct support to youth with developmental disabilities in a variety of community-based settings
- Manage petty cash, participant attendance and other program-related records
- Maintain effective, open communication with Individuals receiving support, co-workers, families, external service providers, and your supervisor.

- Provide quality support consistent with Agency Policies & Procedures, Mission, Vision & Core Values, and Ministry of Children Community and Social Services (MCCSS) requirements.
- Promote a safe environment for both staff and supported individuals.
- Ability to work and contribute in a team environment.

Education and Qualifications

- Post-Secondary Student (minimum of one year of completed education in a Human Services or Recreational field of study, preferred)
- Experience working with individuals with developmental disabilities, preferred.
- Experience working with youth, preferred.
- Must be flexible and available to work a variety of shifts including days, evenings, and weekends.
- Valid Class "G" Ontario Driver's Licence and able to utilize your personal, adequately insured vehicle (proof of minimum \$1million liability insurance) for work purposes.
- Valid First Aid/CPR certificate.
- Vulnerable Sector Police Check

Compensation and Benefits:

- This is a seasonal contract position with an expected start date of May 19, 2026, and ending no later than August 21, 2026.
- 35 hours per week. The successful candidate must be available and flexible for changing schedules, working days, evenings, and weekends to accommodate program needs.
