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Our **Services**

Through a person-centred planning process, each individual develops a dynamic plan that identifies their goals, dreams and ambitions. These plans outline the level and type of support desired and CLKD's role in facilitating meaningful community participation and inclusion.

Community Participation Supports

Individuals participate in recreational, educational, social and volunteer opportunities in our community that match their interests and fulfill their personal goals. Community Participation Supports fosters personal growth, skill development, social networks and a strong, diverse and welcoming community.

Accommodation Supports

24-Hour Support

CLKD provides 24-hour support to 17 individuals at agency-owned residences located in established Kincardine neighbourhoods. These comfortable, caring and supportive living environments promote independence, active participation in the community and the opportunity to enjoy inclusive lives.

Supported Independent Living

Adults living in their own home or apartment receive personalized assistance with elements of daily living and developing community connections to maintain their independence.

Infant and Child Development

The Infant and Child Development program supports families with babies or toddlers who have a developmental disability or are at risk for a delay. Families receive in-home support as they learn about parenting their child and are provided with information and resources related to their child's needs. Links and coordination with additional community support services are established when appropriate.

Family Support Services

Family Support Coordinators assist families who have a child or adult family member with a developmental disabilities living in their home. Assistance is tailored to each family's need but may include case coordination, respite, short and long-term planning, funding applications, school and transition support. Family Support coordinates recreation opportunities, a community-based summer program for youth and parent support groups.

Employment and Employer Support

Building on their strengths, interests, abilities and experience, individuals enhance their career readiness, recieve personalized job search support and discover employment opportunities in the community.

CLKD also works closely with employers, matching the skills and interests of potential employees with the needs of local businesses. Customized on-site coaching and job tailoring can be provided until employees gain confidence, attain independence and thrive in their role.
